Robert Farlow commits hundreds of hours each month to coordinating and organizing the Memorial Mustangs Outreach Bunch (MMOB). The MMOB organization is composed of over 800 student members from Memorial High School. Robert has established a MMOB website to communicate and coordinate Memorial High School's largest club that provides community service almost every weekend. The outstanding community service that is provided by the MMOB has been recognized as a *Class of 2008 SBISD Good Neighbor* and at the state level. In January they were awarded the *Texas Association of Partners in Education Crystal Award* for service learning. These MHS students log over 10,000 hours annually in a variety of activities from planting trees, and mentoring middle school students to beach clean ups in Galveston. Mr. Farlow is helping to build a generation of community minded individuals that know the importance of giving back.
