In accordance with Section 33.902 of the Texas Education Code, the District must annually hold two public hearings on the need for and availability of child care. The hearing allows the public an opportunity to comment on, or offer suggestions regarding the need for and availability of child care before and/or after the school day and during school holidays for the District's school age students.

The district cooperates with the Clay Road YMCA to make after school child care available at various District elementary schools. This program offers students the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities after school. The activities offered within the scope of the program are founded on the 40 Development assets, which enhance character development. During the 2007-2008 school year, the YMCA sites include:
